
Spatial Temporal Activity Recorder (STAR)






How to use and navigate STAR

STAR Navigation STAR navigation is consistent throughout the application. The Main Menu remains visible in all other areas of STAR Clicking the word 'STAR' in the Main Menu returns the user to the home page. Field Workers, Project and Program Managers have 'Quick Access' hyperlinks to a range of other STAR attributes beyond those shown in the Main Menu. These hyperlinks are located on the left-hand side of the screen from a selected program, project or activity. These hyperlinks support navigation within a selected program, project or activity. 




How to use and navigate STAR
