How to clear your browser cache

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Context: An over full browser cache may cause your STAR session to run slowly or stop working. When using STAR, you should clear your browser cache periodically.

A web cache temporarily stores web pages and images to reduce bandwidth usage and

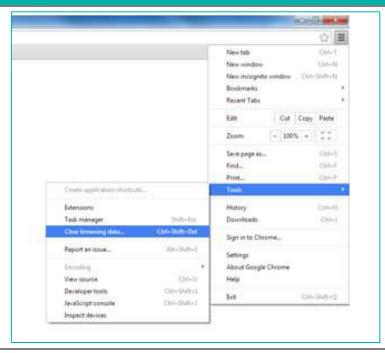

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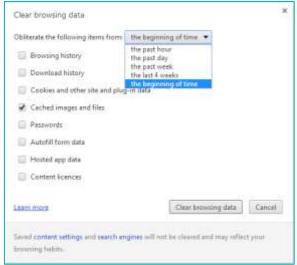
Select 'Clear browsing data'
