Click 'Edit Site' on the map

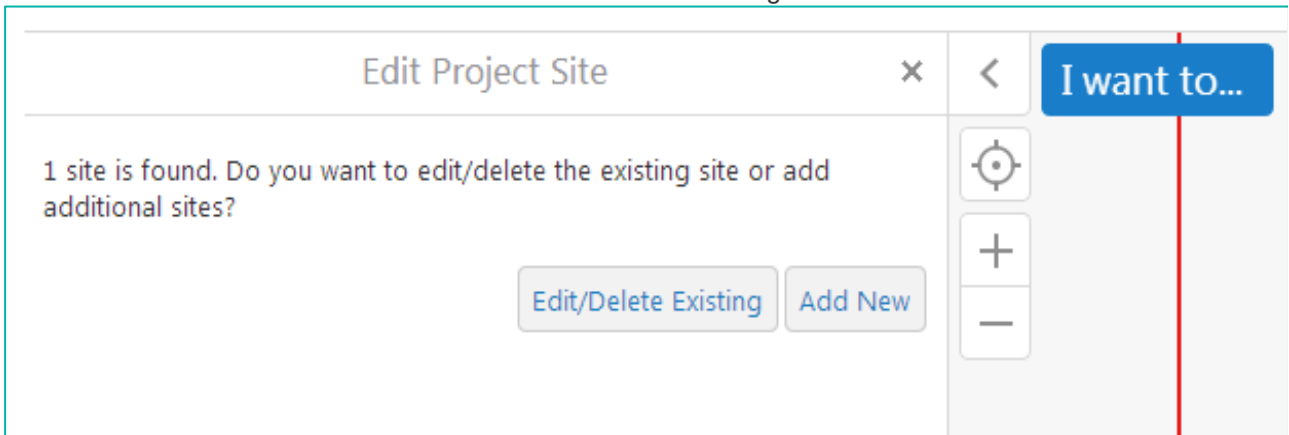

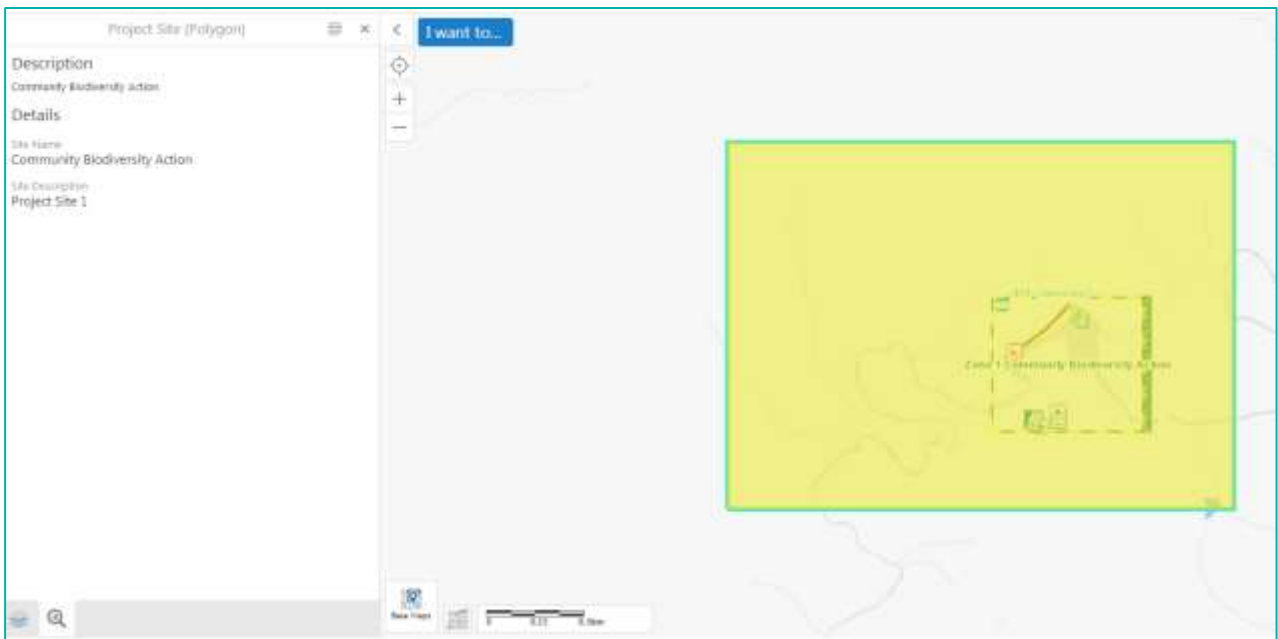

# How to edit a feature

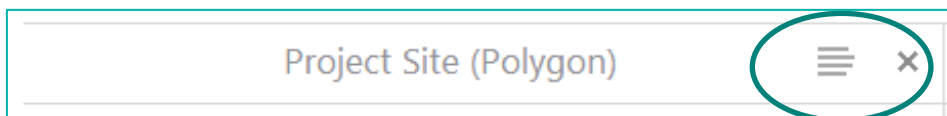
Click Edit delete existing



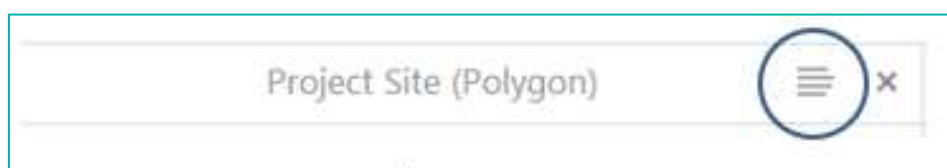
The polygon(s) available for editing from the page are displayed. When selected the polygon is highlighted on the map



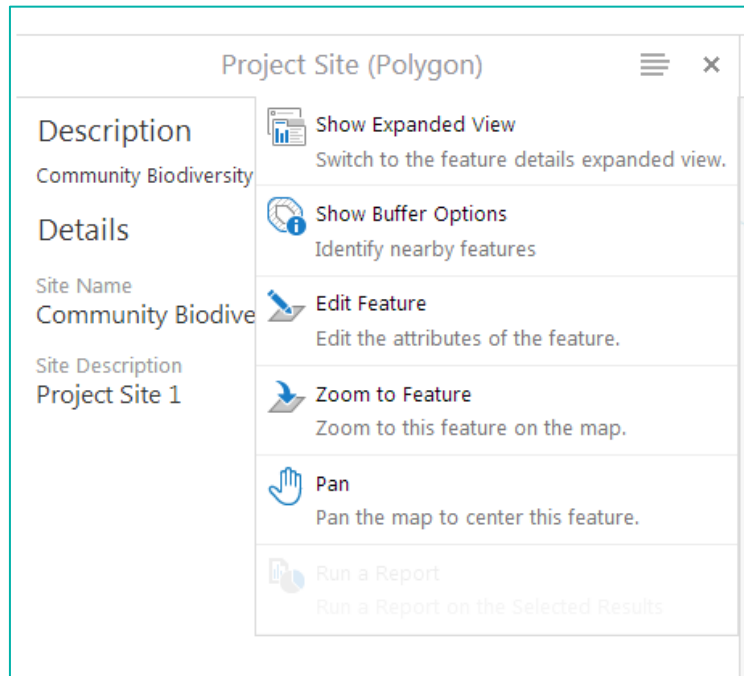
At the top right of the information menu there are two buttons the 'Panel Actions Menu' and the 'Close Menu'



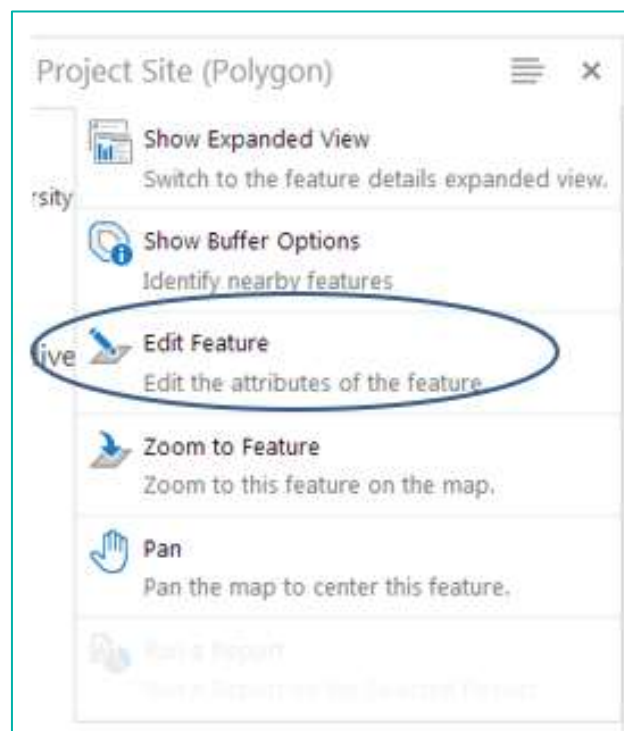
Click the 'Panel Actions Menu'

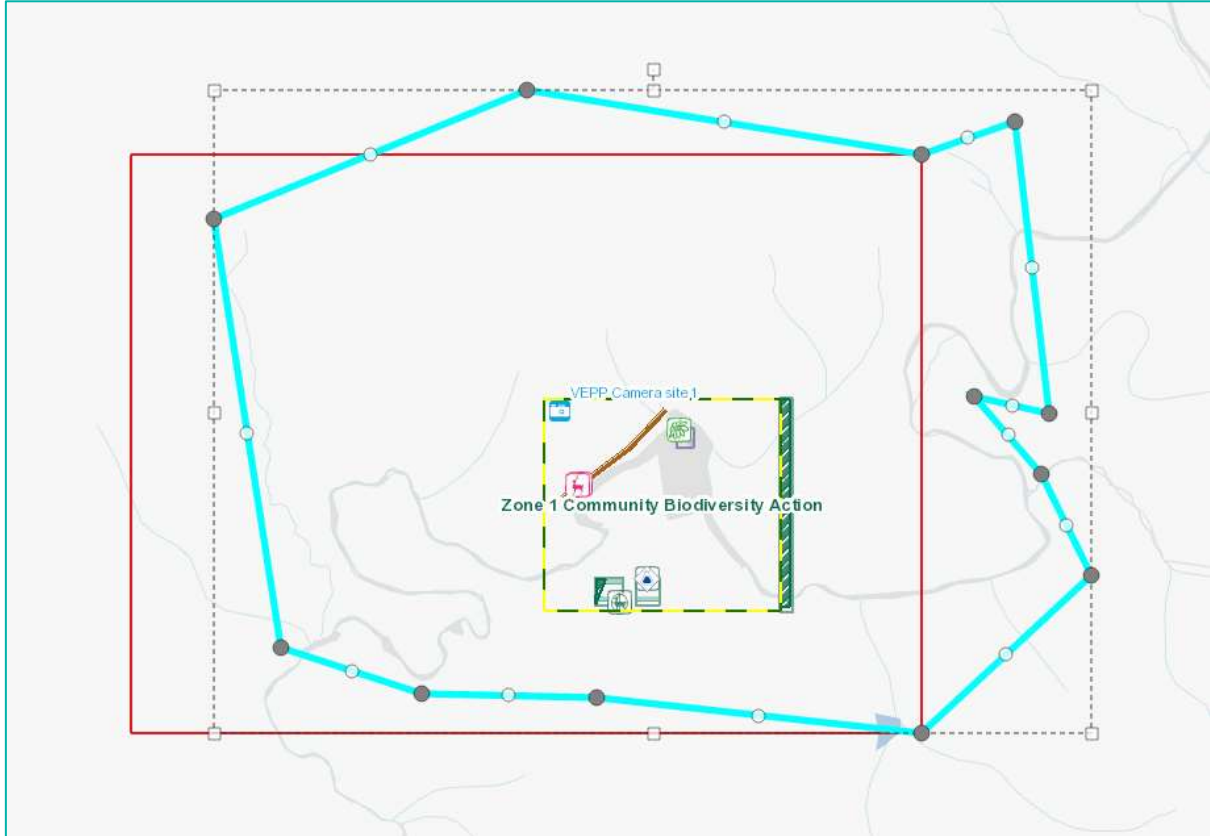

Use the screen instructions to edit the feature or, using the mouse click on the points (vertices) and drag them to the new position(s)



The original feature will remain on the screen and the edited feature will be highlighted. Each time a point is moved new points appear on the map allowing finer editing.

Click 'Save Geometry' to stop editing.

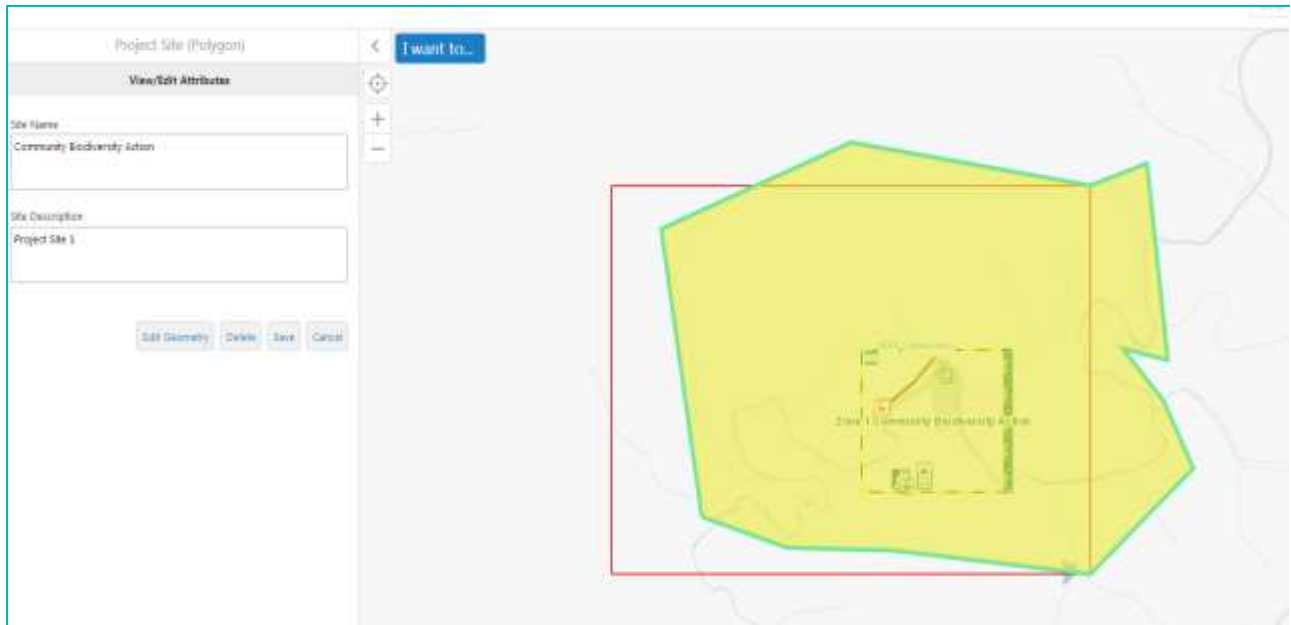



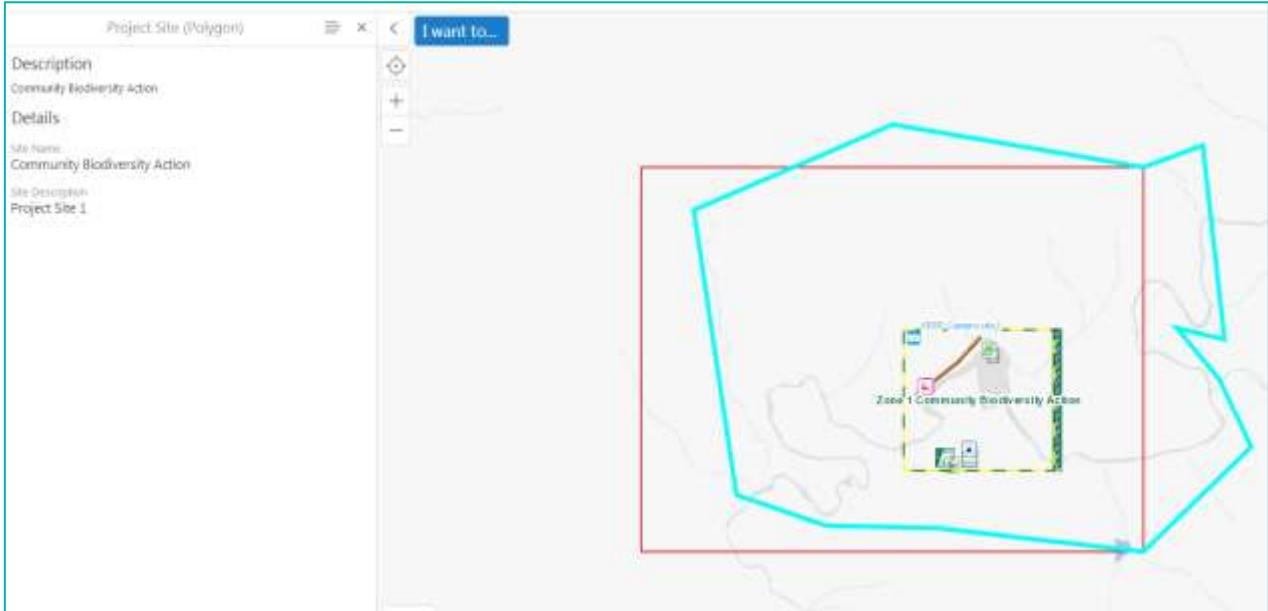

Clicking Edit Geometry will return to continuing editing the feature.

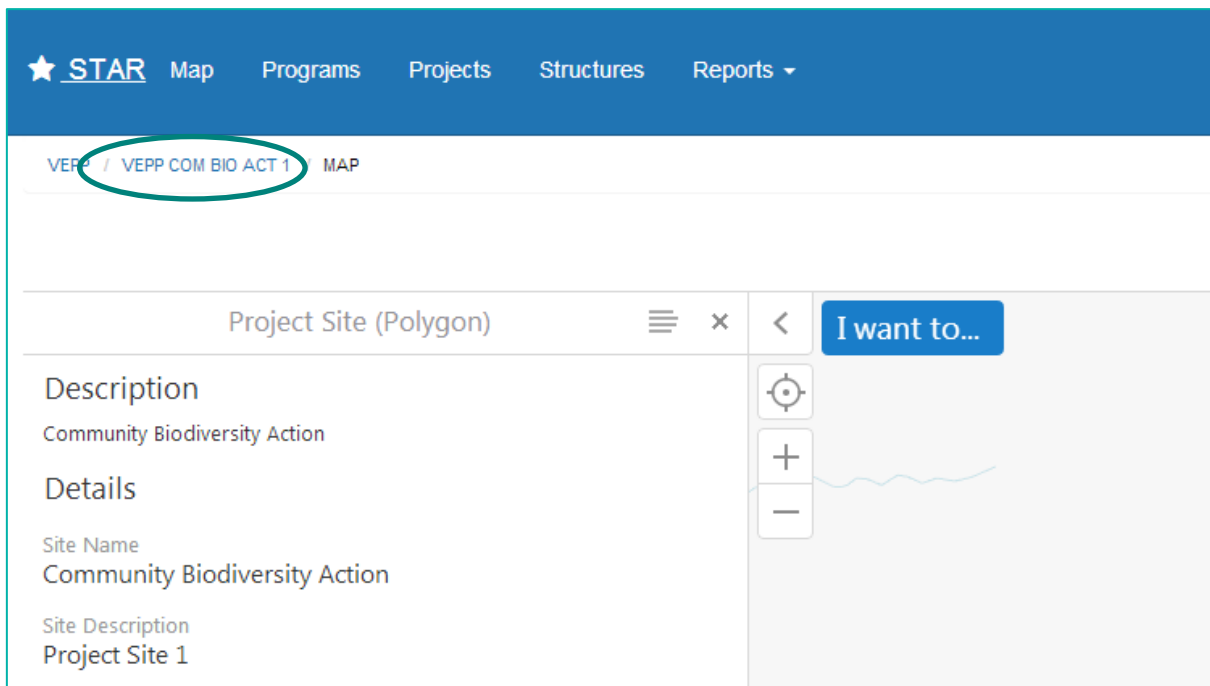
Clicking 'Delete' will delete the feature
