How to find a project or activity using the 'ldentify' function in the map

TIP : Zooming to the general location of the feature (e.g. Project) that you are looking for will reduce the number of 'Search Results' returned from using the Identify tool. Instructions below.	
 To zoom to the general location of the feature (e.g. project) that you are looking for, either: Click the Zoom In button in the tools menu and click on the screen, or Click the mouse on the map then scroll the mouse wheel. 	€ Zoom In
To move the map around the screen so that you click the Pan button then move the mouse over the map and holding the right-hand mouse button down drag the map around the screen until your location is in the centre of the map.	Pan
Click the Rectangle Identify button in the tool bar	Point Rectangle
A message will appear at the bottom of the Map.	To learn what's there, click or tap and drag to draw a rectangle on the map.
From near the feature of interest with the right mouse button depressed, drag a rectangle that includes the feature you are interested in. The area selected will be shaded
