

## Recognised Road Safety Projects

The *Procedure to Rely on the Road Safety Exemption in Planning Schemes* (DELWP 2018) affords special provisions to specific road safety programs that have either been listed in the procedure or subsequently approved for inclusion by the Secretary to the Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action (DEECA).

Road safety programs are specifically developed and funded to target road safety issues on existing roads, with the expectation that the works will directly result in a reduction in serious accidents or fatalities.

The following road safety programs are listed in the procedure or have been subsequently recognised as of 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024:
