

Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988
NOTICE OF DECISION UNDER SECTION 16G

In accordance with section 16G of the **Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988**, I, Steve Dimopoulos, Minister for Environment, and I, Ros Spence, Minister for Agriculture have:

- (i) considered the recommendation of the Scientific Advisory Committee regarding Satinwood (*Nematolepis squamea* subsp. *squamea*) as published on the Internet at <https://www.environment.vic.gov.au/conserving-threatened-species/threatened-list> and in the Government Gazette on 24 September 2024; and
- (ii) decided to retain the taxon described in Column 1 of Table 1 in the Schedule to this Notice in the Threatened List as Vulnerable in Victoria for the reason that it meets the criterion shown in Column 5 of that Table.

SCHEDULE

In Table 1 in this Schedule—

5.1 means Primary Criterion **5.1** of Schedule 1 to the Flora and Fauna Guarantee Regulations 2020 which provides that the taxon of flora or fauna is vulnerable.

5.1.1 means Subcriterion **5.1.1** of Schedule 1 to the Flora and Fauna Guarantee Regulations 2020 which provides that the taxon has undergone, is suspected to have undergone or is likely to undergo in the immediate future a substantial reduction in population size.
