New Dog Parks

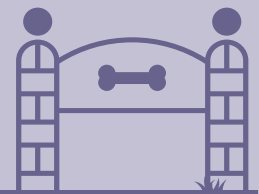
The \$5 million New Dog Parks Program is establishing 15 new off-leash dog parks in built-up urban areas across metropolitan Melbourne.

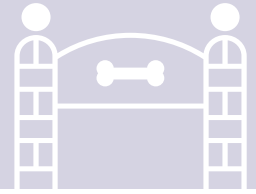

This park will provide the community with a safe and enclosed off leash space for dogs. The park will include a sand digging zone, sensory play zone, agility zone, rock scramble zone and open runabout zone.
