2022 Snapshot



Victorian Landcare Grants
\$4.1 million for 206 Project Grants and 282 Support Grants



Victorian Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grants
\$413,000 for 111 projects



Victorian Landcare Facilitator Program
\$4.4 million to support 740 groups and networks



Regional Landcare Coordination
\$1.7 million for 10 Regional Landcare Coordinators



Environmental volunteers supported by the Victorian Landcare Facilitator Program made a **\$12.06 Million economic contribution***
*Based on a monetary value of \$41.72/hour for volunteer contribution



Group Health – **84%** of Landcare groups and networks **healthy and functioning well***
*Based on self-reporting of group health as ok, strong or thriving

Biodiversity 2037 Contribution Highlights



12,686 volunteers acted for nature through the Victorian Landcare Program, contributing a huge **288,986 volunteer hours**



Community grants supported **threatened species** by creating wildlife corridors for Malleefowl, protecting habitat for Helmeted Honeyeaters and restoring ecosystems for critically endangered Bog Gum



23,126 Ha of revegetation, weed control and herbivore control was undertaken to protect Victoria's biodiversity



32,000 participants connected with nature at Landcare Facilitator supported education and engagement events
