Victorian Landcare Grants

Project name: Project Windharp - Protection of Buloke Landscape
Funding recipient: Buloke and Northern Grampians Landcare Network

Project location: St Arnaud

Outcomes:

Improved and protected a four hectare remnant patch of vulnerable species Buloke (*Allocasuarina luehmannii*) by:

- Planting approximately 3,000 Buloke and allied species
- Installing exclusion fencing
- Delivering a Buloke education campaign, highlighting its importance in the landscape



Victorian Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grants

Project name: Young people restoring threatened ecosystems

Funding recipient: Bacchus Marsh Grammar

Project location: Staughton Vale

Outcomes:

Enabled and encouraged young people to explore and share awareness of climate change within their communities.

Engaged students in habitat restoration and highlighted the importance of indigenous vegetation to mitigate climate change.



Victorian Landcare Facilitator Program

Project name: Mornington Peninsula Landcare Facilitator

Funding recipient: Mornington Peninsula Shire Council

Outcomes:

Landcare Facilitator Chantal Morton brings together the Peninsula's 13 Landcare groups, landowners, and government agencies to help tackle big issues. In 2021-22, Chantal collaborated with Mornington Peninsula Koala Conservation on a large-scale biolink project to create a continuous corridor of eucalyptus trees to help koalas thrive. Over 20,000 trees were planted across 26 private properties to form the biolink.
