Victorian Landcare Grants
\$3.98 million* 244 Project Grants delivered and 269 Support Grants



Victorian Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grants
\$471,943* for 123 projects



Victorian Landcare Facilitator Program \$4.6 million
80 Landcare facilitators supporting 743 groups and networks.



Regional Coordination \$1.8 million
10 Regional Landcare Coordinators, 100+ regional meetings, 187 training events engaging 3,500 people, 700 project grants managed

Biodiversity 2037 Contribution Highlights



345,309 plants planted



27,596 volunteers acted for nature through the Victorian Landcare Program, contributing **383,049 volunteer hours**



21,073 Ha of habitat protection, revegetation, weed control and herbivore control was undertaken to protect Victoria's biodiversity



51,307 participants connected with nature at Landcare Facilitator supported education and engagement events

Landcare grants supported **threatened species and communities** by protecting and connecting Victorian Volcanic Plain remnant grasslands, restoring Buloke woodlands, and enhancing habitat for Gang Gang cockatoo, Leadbeater's Possum, Brush-tailed Phascogale, Barking Owl, Bog Gum and Growling Grass Frog.
